- Two weeks with the Marketing Team & Contracts Team Gain insights into internal and external marketing, project branding, and contract administration.

This immersive experience is a great opportunity to "dip your toes" into real estate while learning directly from members of the Tarragon team. By the end of the program, interns will have a broader understanding of how different real estate sectors operate and work together. Depending on one's school schedule, our summer internship program is scheduled to run from May 2025 to the end of September 2025.
